



Proposed changes to the Electricity Supplier Obligation Regulations in response to COVID-19

Issued 04 June 2020

Dear Stakeholder,

BEIS have issued the Government response to the consultation issued last month on Proposed changes to the Electricity Supplier Obligation Regulations in response to COVID-19. As highlighted in our bulletin on 13th May 2020, this refers to the BEIS offer of a one-off interest free loan to LCCC to reduce supplier obligations in the short term.

The key messages from this response are:

- Suppliers will be protected from 80% of the increase in obligations relating to the current quarter (up to the maximum loan amount of £100m), higher than the 67% originally proposed.
- Subject to approval by Parliament, The Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier
 Obligations) Regulations 2014 will be amended to implement the proposals as set out in the
 consultation, with the exception that the amount deferred through use of the loan will be
 recovered in Q2 of 2021 and not Q1, following feedback from respondents.
- There will also be an amendment to the ESO Regulations to allow LCCC to consider
 anticipated receipt or repayment of the Government loan when setting the interim levy rate
 (ILR) and / or total reserve amount (TRA) for a quarter or making in-period adjustments.
- The amended ESO Regulations were laid in Parliament on 4 June in anticipation that
 Parliament can approve them before 9 July, when LCCC is due to carry out the reconciliation
 process for the current quarter.
