LCCC opens window onto CfD data

Low Carbon Contracts Company (LCCC) is delighted to announce the launch of new CfD dashboards. These new windows onto data held by LCCC build on our existing capabilities, with the aim of improving understanding of the CfD scheme and how its projects are progressing.

The dashboards give accessible views onto the CfD portfolio, forecasts of energy production, and information on actual generation and cash flows, broken down by technology and other criteria. The portfolio view brings the existing CfD Register to life and shows how the portfolio will grow in the years ahead, while the forecasts give projections of CfD projects' future generation. Actuals, meanwhile, show how active CfD projects have already contributed to Great Britain's electricity mix.

LCCC plans to further develop the functionality of the CfD dashboards, and also provide more context to support our stakeholders' understanding of how the CfD scheme operates and the part it plays in decarbonising our electricity system.

Neil McDermott, Chief Executive of LCCC, said: "This initiative is in line with the Government-appointed Energy Data Taskforce recommendations on data openness, and LCCC is pleased to be delivering on this objective so soon after the publication of the Taskforce's report. We look forward to building on this step to give further insight into the schemes we manage."
