The [CfD register](#) has been updated today to include data about all twelve projects awarded as a result of Allocation Round three (AR3). Also, the Register has been re-designed to offer improved search functionality and clearer project location information. Further improvements in the usability of the Register are planned, while Allocation Round 3 current strike prices will be added to the data once calculated during the 2020 strike price adjustment cycle, in accordance with conditions 14.3 and 20.3 of the CfD Standard Terms and Conditions.
