### Three wind farms start to receive CfD payments

One offshore and two onshore wind farms, Phase 1 of East Anglia One, Nanclach and Clocaenog Forest, have recently passed all the Contracts for Difference (CfD) Operational Conditions Precedent and started to receive CfD payments for generated electricity on the dates below.

### **Drax achieves Final Installed Capacity milestone**

Drax Power Limited passed its Final Installed Capacity (FIC) milestone on 16 October 2019, after providing evidence of 645MW installed capacity for the third biomass unit conversion, Drax Unit 1. Drax was awarded its Investment Contract in May 2014 and on 21 December 2016 Unit 1 commissioned as a converted facility running on renewable biomass fuel.
