BEIS issues consultation on proposed changes to Supplier Obligation Regulations

BEIS has released a consultation on proposed changes to the Regulations to reflect how the one-off, interest-free loan [to be provided by BEIS to LCCC](#) would work in practice in reducing the supplier obligations in the short term, and the recovery mechanics of this loan. The consultation covers how the amount of the loan will be determined, and how this amount will be translated into reductions in current supplier obligations and increases in a future quarter.
